Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q. Does my pharmacy network have both CVS and Walgreens in it?

A. No. Your plan doesn't cover prescriptions at both CVS and Walgreens. Walgreens is in-network and CVS is out-of-network. You have the option to change your network, if you'd like.

Q. Is Walgreens the only retail pharmacy chain in my network?

A. No. Your network has thousands of retail pharmacies in it, including other major pharmacy chains (besides Walgreens), local independent pharmacies, grocery store pharmacies and wholesale warehouse store pharmacies.

Your plan is just giving you (and each of your covered family members) the option to choose which major pharmacy chain (Walgreens or CVS) you want in your network.

Q. Why did you give me the pharmacy network with Walgreens in it?

A. We looked at which pharmacy (Walgreens or CVS) you use most often to fill prescriptions, and we put you in the network that has that retail pharmacy chain in it.

If you don't use either of these two pharmacies, we put you in the network your plan picked or the one the plan's subscriber picked. If you want to have a different pharmacy in your network, you can make the change online or over the phone.

Q. I don't use CVS or Walgreens. Can I still use my current pharmacy?

A. Yes, as long as your pharmacy is in-network. Your network has over 55,000 pharmacies* in it, so you have many places to choose from. To learn more about your network, log in to the myCigna App or [myCigna.com](https://mycigna.com).

Q. I want to change my pharmacy network so CVS is in it (instead of Walgreens). How do I do that?

A. Here are two ways you can change your network:

1. **By phone:** Call customer service using the toll-free number on your Cigna Healthcare ID card. Let them know you'd like to change your pharmacy network. Or
2. **Online:** When your new plan year starts, log in to the myCigna App or [myCigna.com](https://mycigna.com). Go to the profile page and follow the on-screen instructions.

It's important to know that you (and your covered family members) can only change your network **one time in a calendar year**. And any change you make will take place within 24 hours.

Q. I use Walgreens, but my son uses CVS. Is that okay?

A. Yes. You and each of your covered family members have the option to choose the network that includes the major retail pharmacy chain (Walgreens or CVS) you'd like to use or use most often. So, you can choose the network with Walgreens in it, and your son can choose the one with CVS in it.

Q. What's an "affiliate pharmacy" and what does this mean for my network options?

A. An "affiliate pharmacy" is usually a smaller pharmacy that's owned by, or financially connected to, another pharmacy (usually a larger pharmacy). Here's what this means:

- **If your pharmacy network has Walgreens in it,** your medication won't be covered⁵ at CVS or any of its affiliate pharmacies.
- **If your pharmacy network has CVS in it,** your medication won't be covered⁵ at Walgreens or any of its affiliate pharmacies.

Q. How do I know which affiliate pharmacies belong to Walgreens and CVS?

A. These are their affiliates:

- **Walgreens:** Ava Drug, Broadwater Drug, Center for Living Well Pharmacy, Cox Drug, DFHC Pharmacy, Dominguez, Drug Warehouse, Duane Reade, Electric Boat Family Pharmacy, Employers Healthcare Center, Golden Health Pharmacy, Happy Harry's, Health Care Center Pharmacy, Kerr Drug, Linn Drug, Living Well Health, Mansfield Drug, Med-X, Murphy Drugs & Gifts, Overturf Pharmacy, Parkway Drugs, Pharmacy for Living Well, Seymour Pharmacy, Stanley, Super D Drug, Super D Express Pharmacy, Taylor's Discount Pharmacy, USA Drug, USA Drug Express and Worksite Pharmacy.
- **CVS:** Long's Drug Store, Longs Drugs, Navarro Discount Pharmacy and Procure Pharmacy Direct.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) (cont.)

Q. My pharmacy isn't in-network. How do I switch pharmacies?

A. Here are two easy ways you can move your prescription:

1. Call your doctor's office. Ask them to send your prescription to your new pharmacy. Or,
2. If your prescription still has a refill available, ask the pharmacist at your new pharmacy to contact your current pharmacy to help move your prescription.

Q. Can I use an out-of-network pharmacy to fill my prescription?

A. To get the most from your plan's coverage, you should use an in-network pharmacy. However, if you choose to use an out-of-network pharmacy, here's what you need to know:

- **If you have out-of-network pharmacy benefits**, you can pay cash for your medication and ask your plan to pay you back your out-of-network cost-share.
- **If you don't have out-of-network pharmacy benefits**, your medication won't be covered. You have the option to fill your medication anyway, without using your health plan (insurance). You'll pay the medication's retail cash price to the pharmacy. It's important to know that if you do this (without using your health plan), the cost can't be applied to your annual deductible or out-of-pocket maximum.

Q. Where can I fill a 30-day prescription?

A. You can use any retail pharmacy in your plan's network.

Q. Where can I fill a 90-day prescription?

A. It depends on your plan. Some plans cover 90-day fills at both in-network retail pharmacies and through home delivery with Express Scripts Pharmacy; others only cover 90-day fills through home delivery. Please log in to the myCigna App or **myCigna.com**, or check your plan materials, to see what your plan allows.

Q. Can I fill my maintenance medication in a 90-day supply through Express Scripts Pharmacy?

A. Yes, as long as your plan allows.⁴ Express Scripts Pharmacy is a convenient option when you're taking a medication on a regular basis to treat an ongoing health condition. It's simple and safe, and saves you trips to the pharmacy. To learn more, go to **Cigna.com/homedelivery**.

- Easily order, manage, track and pay for your medications on your phone or online.
- Get standard shipping at no extra cost.⁶
- Fill up to a 90-day supply at one time.³
- Talk with a pharmacist, 24/7.
- Sign up for automatic refills or refill reminders so you don't miss a dose.⁷
- Use a payment plan (if you need it).

Here are two easy ways to get started:

1. **Online.** Log in to the myCigna App or **myCigna.com** and click on the Prescriptions tab. Choose My Medications from the dropdown list. Then click the button next to your medication name to move your prescription(s) from your retail pharmacy to home delivery. Or,

2. **By phone.**

- Call your doctor's office. Ask them to send a 90-day prescription (with refills) to Express Scripts home delivery. Or,
- Call Express Scripts Pharmacy at **800.835.3784**. They'll contact your doctor's office to get your prescription. Have your ID card, doctor's contact information and medication name(s) ready when you call.

Q. Can Express Scripts Pharmacy help move my prescription to their pharmacy?

A. Yes. Just call **800.835.3784** and have your Cigna Healthcare ID card, doctor's contact information and medication name(s) ready when you call. Express Scripts Pharmacy will do the rest.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) (cont.)

Q. Can I fill my specialty medication through Accredo?

A. Yes, as long as your plan allows.⁴ Accredo's team will give you the personalized care and support you need to manage your therapy. They'll also fill and ship your medication to you.

- Talk with specially-trained pharmacists and nurses, 24/7.
- Better understand your condition and how to take your medication in a way that works best for you.
- Get fast shipping on your medications at no extra cost.⁶
- Get help paying for your medications (if you need it).
- Sign up for refills and reminders.
- Easily manage your medications and track your orders online.

1. There are thousands of pharmacies in this network – including other major retail pharmacy chains (besides Walgreens), local pharmacies, grocery stores and wholesale warehouse stores. To find an in-network pharmacy, log in to the myCigna App or myCigna.com and click on the Prescriptions tab; then choose Price a Medication from the dropdown list.
2. App/online store terms and mobile phone carrier/data charges apply. Customers under age 13 (and/or their parent/guardian) will not be able to register at myCigna.com.
3. **Not all plans cover 90-day fills at both in-network retail pharmacies and through home delivery with Express Scripts Pharmacy.** Some only cover 90-day fills through home delivery. Please log in to the myCigna app or myCigna.com, or check your plan materials, to see what your plan allows. Also, some medications aren't available in a 90-day supply and may only be packaged in lesser amounts. For example, oral contraceptives come in a 3-pack, which is an 84-day supply. It's important to know that even though it's not a full "90-day supply," we still think of it as a 90-day prescription.
4. Not all plans offer Express Scripts Pharmacy and Accredo as covered pharmacy options. Log in to the myCigna App or myCigna.com, or check your plan materials, to learn more about the pharmacies in your plan's network. Cigna Healthcare, Evernorth Health Services, Express Scripts Pharmacy and Accredo are all part of The Cigna Group. This means we have an ownership interest in these pharmacies; However, you have the right to fill prescriptions at any pharmacy in your plan's network (as your plan allows).
5. Please check your plan materials to learn about your out-of-network coverage. If you don't have out-of-network pharmacy benefits, your plan won't cover the cost of any medications you fill at this pharmacy. You'll have to switch to an in-network pharmacy for your medication to be covered. If you have out-of-network pharmacy benefits, you can pay cash for your medication and ask your plan to pay you back your out-of-network cost-share. To do this, log in to the myCigna App or myCigna.com and fill out the online reimbursement form or go to the "Forms Center" and print out a Claims Form to mail to Cigna Healthcare.
6. Your plan pays the cost for standard shipping.
7. Express Scripts Pharmacy can automatically refill certain medications. Log in to the myCigna App or myCigna.com, or call 800.835.3784, to sign up. You can also sign up to get emails and/or texts from Express Scripts Pharmacy. To get text messages, you'll have to sign up for the Express Scripts texting service. You can do this online or when you call 800.835.3784 to refill your prescription. Once you sign up, simply reply to their welcome text to get started. Standard text messaging rates apply.
